#### **RECOUNTS AFTER THE GENERAL ELECTION**

Fourteen requests for recounts for the Office of State Representative were received after the general election. Two recounts resulted in a change of winners - Hillsborough County District No. 40 and Sullivan County District No. 4. The request for a recount in Cheshire County District No. 8 was withdrawn and the requests in Cheshire County District No. 2 and Strafford County District No. 13 were called off before they were completed.

Appeals were made to the Ballot Law Commission after the recounts were completed for races in Hillsborough County District No. 11, Hillsborough County District No. 40, Rockingham County District No. 27 and Sullivan County District No. 4. There were no changes in winners as a result of the appeals.

Below, in the first column are the figures as officially returned to the Secretary of State. The second column contains the recount figures and the third column the Ballot Law Commission figures. The persons elected are designated by asterisks.
