Question No. 1. Shall there be a convention to amend or revise the constitution?

Are you in favor of amending the constitution to provide that 12-person juries shall be required in capital cases and in cases in which imprisonment may exceed one year; but that, in civil cases and in cases in which imprisonment may be one year or less, a 6-person jury shall be required? (Passed by N.H. House 318 Yes 18 No, passed State Senate 22 Yes 1 No) (CACR 11)

Are you in favor of amending the constitution to provide that the legislature may delegate regulatory authority to executive branch officials, but that any proposed rules may be disapproved by the legislature or an appropriate legislative committee, as prescribed by law?
