### **RECOUNTS AFTER THE GENERAL ELECTION**

After the general election, there were nine requests for recounts received.

On November 20, 1978, two senatorial district races were recounted, Senate District No. 7 and Senate District No. 14. In Senate District No. 7, John P. H. Chandler, Jr. was declared the winner; however, Peter Allen won the recount. There was no change in the Senate District No. 14 race.

One recount, for Representative to the General Court in Merrimack County, District No. 7 (Allenstown, Pembroke), was conducted on November 21, 1978. There was no change.

On November 27, 1978, five recounts for Representative to the General Court were conducted: Keene Ward 1, Keene Ward 4, Windham, Salem, and Merrimack County District No. 5 (Bow, Dunbarton). After the recount in Keene Ward 4, Floyd Kohl and Albert Munichiello were tied. The tie was determined by lot and Albert Munichiello was the winner.\*\* There were no changes in the other Representative races.

The final recount was held November 27, 1978. This was for Strafford County Commissioner and there was no change.

Following are the tables, with the persons elected indicated by an asterisk.

<sup>\*\*</sup>Breaking the tie by lot was appealed to the Ballot Law Commission and the Commission ordered a run-off election. The Ballot Law Commission decision was appealed to the House of Representatives. On January 3, 1979, the House of Representatives ordered a run-off election.
